

ORARI NATIONAL AWARD PROGRAM

GENERAL RULES

- ORARI Awards will be issued to licensed amateurs the world over for 2 x PHONE, 2 x CW, 2 x RTTY, mixed or single mode, mixed or single band in 8Ø, 4Ø, 2Ø, 15, and 1Ø meter band only. SWL Award in the same category will also be available. The applicant may request endorsement for such distinction accordingly.
- To be valid, all contact or listening must be made on or after July 9, 1968.
- Claim must be accompanied by a QSL card list (GCR) furnished with the callsigns of stations worked, dates, bands and modes of contact meeting the requirements of the award concerned. Rules and requirements will be specified, when required, in each of the Award Program.
- QSL card list must be accompanied by a statement from the applicant's National Society, Club Station, or from any two amateurs other than the applicant, that the QSL cards of the contact listed are in the possession of the applicant, and that the items of the cards are correctly listed.
- A fee of US \$ 10.ØØ (eight US Dollar only) or 16 (sixteen) IRCs will be charged per award and should be sent along with the application to the respective Awards Manager.
- For the Indonesian amateurs, a fee of Rp. 6Ø.ØØØ,- (Sixty thousands rupiahs) will be charged per award, and valid for Jakarta, Worked All Indonesia and Worked the Equator Awards only.
- Only contact with land station within the same country will be acceptable.
- To apply, send the log extract (GCR), in alphabetical order by prefix along with the award fee to the AWARD MANAGER: P.O. BOX 1Ø96, JAKARTA 1ØØ1Ø INDONESIA

AWARD NOTES

When applying for an award, courtesy demands that you observe the following:

1. Print your name, callsign and address.
2. Clearly state what award and endorsements you are applying for.
3. Send the application to the respective Award Manager according to the award claimed and enclose the award fee (in money order or IRCs) as requested. PERSONAL CHEQUES IS NOT ACCEPTED.
4. For the Indonesian amateurs application must use the Model-K form issued by the ORARI National QSL & Awards Bureau and may be sent directly to the respective Awards Manager for verification and award issue, or having them checked and verified by the assigned ORARI Daerah / Lokal nearest to their location. A SASE or sufficient funds for return postage should be enclosed along with the application.

AMATEUR RADIO AWARD'S DIRECTORY

WTEA (WORKED THE EQUATOR AWARD)

Issued for confirmed contacts with stations along the earth's Equator in the following countries: C2 HC HC8 HK KH1/KB6 PR-PY PY0/St. Peter S9/Sao Tome T30 T31 T32 TN TR YB5 YB7 YB8 5X 6O 8O 8Q 9Q 9O. SWL OK. Three categories of the award are as follows:

- Class I - confirmed contact/SWL with 15 above countries.
- Class II - confirmed contact/SWL with 12 above countries.
- Class III - confirmed contact/SWL with 8 above countries.

For all classes, YB5, YB7 and YB8 are mandatory.



WORKED ALL INDONESIA AWARD (WAIA)



Issued for contact with stations in each of the Indonesia call areas (1 to 0) as follows:

- DX stations other than those in CQ Zone 28 need two stations in each area. (total of 20 QSL cards).
- DX stations in Zone 28 need three stations in each call area. (30 QSLs)
- Indonesian amateurs need five stations in each call area. (50 QSLs) Additionally, they need contact with 3 station classes, YB/YE, YC/YF, YD/YG in the same call area is compulsory.

Modes or bands may be mixed. SWL OK. Contacts after 7 Sept 1968.

JAKARTA AWARD



Issued for contact with stations in Jakarta (0 call area), the capital of the Republic of Indonesia.

DX stations need 20, including at least one Jakarta club station. Indonesian stations need 50 including at least five Jakarta club stations.

Modes and bands may be mixed. Contacts after 7 Sept 1968. SWL OK.

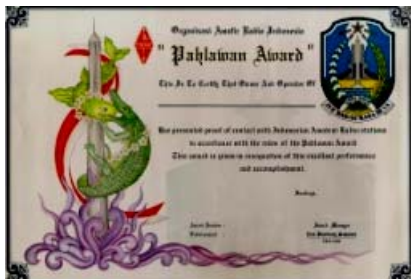
Contact stations in North Sumatra 6th call area. Indonesians need 20 different including 3 club stations; all others need 10 and one club station.

ASIAN AFRICAN SUMMIT GOLDEN JUBILEE AWARD



Commemorating 50 years of the Asia-African Conference, the Organisasi Amatir Radio Indonesia (ORARI) issued the Asian African Summit Golden Jubilee Award.

This Special Award will be issued once only this year 2005.

Rules.

1. This Award will be available to licenced amateur stations who will submit their log extracts showing satisfactory evidence of having conducted communication with 30 licenced amateur stations which last letter of their suffixes made up the sentence: **"ASIA-AFRICAN SUMMIT GOLDEN JUBILEE"**
2. No QSL cards needed
3. Valid contacts should be April 17 through August 31,2005 with phone mode, cw mode or mixed of phone and cw modes.
4. Two categories of Awards:
 - Principal Award : QSO with 30 stations, inclusive YE5ØAA, on the HF band. (YE5ØAA will only work on HF Band from 22 through 24 April 2005)
 - Basic Award : QSO with 30 stations on the HF or VHF band
